## **JOINED FORCES FOR WOUND PATIENT RIGHTS TO HIGH QUALITY WOUND CARE**

This year's conference of the European Wound Management Association is held as a joined conference:

The 26<sup>th</sup> Conference of the European Wound Management Association (EWMA), the 10<sup>th</sup> Deutscher Wundkongress and the 2<sup>nd</sup> WundD.A.C.H conference have joined forces and offer participants a very comprehensive programme with sessions in English and/or German, focusing on a variety of topics related to wound management.

Together, we expect to welcome 5000-7000 participants in Bremen between 11-13 May 2016.

The overall theme of the conference is *"Patients – Wounds – Rights"*. With this theme, the three organisations wish to highlight the continuous need to ensure that wound management is offered with a holistic approach to the patient and that the wound patient's right to receive the most appropriate care is safeguarded throughout Europe. One of the primary preconditions for achieving this is the involvement of interdisciplinary teams in wound management.

As an association representing many disciplines, specialities and countries, it lies in the nature of EWMA to open up for widely different interests and perspectives on best practice wound care. We have therefore invited a number of our partner organisations in Europe and internationally to present their views on different aspects of wound management in the light of today's challenges. These will be offered in parallel to the key sessions planned by EWMA, free paper sessions, as well as the scientific programme offered in German by the Deutscher Wundkongress.

In total, more than 1000 scientific presentations will take place during the three day conference, which is held in Messe Bremen in the city of Bremen, Germany. More than 180 companies will be exhibiting their newest products.

We look forward to welcoming an international group of participants to this event, which also marks the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of EWMA, and the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Deutscher Wundkongress.
